Meeting called to order by Arleen Hubble

Minutes of Previous Meeting- approved as submitted.

Reports from officers:

Treasurers Report – see financial statement, attached. We received \$2,000 from Red Canoe Credit Union. We are in pretty good shape for the 2010 festival.

Committee Reports:

Parks Dept. - Al George reported that the Lake is being considered for historic preservation. It is unknown how or if this would affect the festival. Gerald Kelly is in charge of that committee, and mentioned to Al that he had an incident with a Go 4th Committee Member last year over tarps. Al suggested we should send him a letter of apology.

Entertainment – Scott Nettling submitted a bid for sound/stage/tents for the festival. \$6,500 total. Motion made by Tom Iverson, seconded by Ray Ryan and passed to accept Scott's bid. Julie will let Scott know. Need to verify if we will be subject to tax on top of the \$6,500.

Buttons- Ray will do buttons again for his locations; will be gone for 2 weeks in April, so goal is to get buttons out in the beginning of April this year. Al suggested we print posters to put in the windows of each business selling buttons....nothing too large, probably 11" x 17". Arleen stressed importance of securing prizes early this year and asked that all committee members help. We will divide the restaurant prizes so not one person has to get all 12. Michele Weber will ask Mark Plotkin if he can secure a trip to Seattle or some other weekend getaway.

Fireworks – No new reports

Portapotties/Handwashing stations/ Garbage – No new reports.

Marketplace – Goal is to get the marketplace letters out by the first of the year. Some of the language and process can be adapted from the food court application process. Harold and Sara Burt stated they would rather observe this year, and can help a little in advance, but not sure how much they can help during the event with their other obligations.

Food Court - Kathi pointed out some flaws in the food vendor contract and application process, e.g.: doesn't have place for 2 signatures, doesn't mention insurance, etc. Kathi suggested food vendors should submit an application with a list of the food they plan to sell, and then we will issue a contract stating what they can serve. Kathi is working on revising the process, using the fair contract for ideas since the language has already been approved by the county attorney.

Prizes – PSA's still running on radio. No response yet. Everyone will step up efforts to secure prizes and will do it earlier this year....too stressful to wait until last minute.

There is only one meeting in December: 12/4/09, and then back to two meetings per month in January: 1/8/10 and 1/22/10. All meetings begin at 7:00am in the Daily News Conference Room.
